### WHO IS IT FOR?

The Legacy Society is for people who:

- Have established permanent endowments with a market value of \$10,000 or more through the Foundation.
- Have made provisions of \$10,000 or more for the Foundation through deferred gifts, such as charitable bequests, charitable remainder trusts, life insurance, real estate, qualified retirement plans, etc.

### MEMBERSHIP FACTS:

- Members are recognized each year in the Foundation's report to the community.
- If you choose, you may retain your anonymity as a member of The Legacy Society.
- You have full access to all donor services offered by the Foundation.
- You are included in an annual event to honor Legacy Society members.
- Disclosures of future commitments are nonbinding.

### HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER:

- Establish an endowed fund valued at \$10,000 at the Foundation or include The Winston-Salem Foundation in your Will or estate plans.
