Andrew Blake Clark Memorial Scholarship

DEADLINE: APRIL 4

The Andrew Blake Clark Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Blake Clark in August 2002 by Dr. Tina Merhoff, and Blake's friends and family. The purpose of the fund is to provide college scholarships to worthy graduating high school seniors at Mt. Tabor High School. Scholarships may be used for tuition, fees, room, board, books, and other related educational expenses at accredited private or public colleges or universities.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

This is a non-renewable scholarship for \$1,000. Award recipients will be selected by the Mt. Tabor High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Criteria for selection will include the following:

- academic promise
- financial need
- school and/or community leadership

The scholarship is available to students regardless of race, sex, national origin, religion, or handicap.

Students interested in being considered for the scholarship award should submit the following to Stan Huck in the Mt. Tabor Guidance Office no later than April 4:

- transcript of high school courses through 1st semester 12th grade
- high school resume
- personal statement describing your accomplishments and future plans

Scholarship checks are jointly payable to the college and the student and are mailed to the student. The student must present the check to the college's financial aid office. The check is not for deposit in the student's personal checking account. Check processing requires approximately two weeks.

The Andrew Blake Clark Memorial Scholarship is administered by The Winston-Salem Foundation. As the fund grows, the number and size of the grants may be increased. Anyone may contribute to the fund at any time. All gifts should be sent directly to The Winston-Salem Foundation and clearly designated for the Andrew Blake Clark Memorial Scholarship.
