

Johnny Lineberry Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

DEADLINE: March 31

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Johnny Lineberry Memorial Scholarship was established in 1990 to provide a scholarship to a worthy Forbush High School senior who will go directly to an accredited vocational/technical school, community college, or college/university in pursuit of a certificate, diploma or baccalaureate degree. The scholarship may provide a \$500 non-renewable award. Scholarships will be applied to the cost of undergraduate tuition, fees, on-campus room and board, books and other college expenses.

CRITERIA:

The scholarship seeks to identify students who:

- are graduating high school seniors from Forbush High School in East Bend, N.C.
- demonstrate a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of at least 2.5
- demonstrate strong character and community involvement
- will study the field of electronics, preferably
- will attend an accredited vocational/technical school, community college or college/university

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Students who are interested in applying for this scholarship should contact the guidance office at Forbush High School or download an application from The Winston-Salem Foundation's Web site at www.wsfoundation.org/students. Completed applications should be submitted to the guidance office.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The Johnny Lineberry Memorial Scholarship Committee will review all completed scholarship applications and select recipients. Members of this Committee may include: two members of the Lineberry family, two members of the standing Scholarship Committee at Forbush High School, and two staff members of Forbush High School, which may include the electronics or computer teacher and the guidance counselor. The Winston-Salem Foundation's Student Aid Committee will have final approval for candidates selected for the awards.

PAYMENT PROCESS:

Once the Foundation receives the selected recipient's information from the scholarship committee), checks will be issued jointly to the college and to the recipient, and will be mailed to the recipient's home address for the student to deliver to the college's financial aid office. Separate checks will be issued for fall and spring semesters. Check processing requires approximately two weeks.

MANAGEMENT OF THE FUNDS:

The Johnny Lineberry Memorial Scholarship Fund is administered by The Winston-Salem Foundation. As the fund grows, the number and amount of scholarships may be increased. Anyone can contribute to the fund at any time. Gifts should be clearly designated for the Johnny Lineberry Memorial Scholarship Fund and mailed directly to the Foundation.
