

Josh Gray Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

DEADLINE: April 15

DESCRIPTION:

The Josh Gray Memorial Scholarship was established in 2005 and was later endowed in 2010 in memory of Josh Gray to provide scholarships to graduating high school seniors who are varsity soccer team members at Mt. Tabor High School. The scholarship may provide a \$1,000 non-renewable award for students who will pursue full-time undergraduate degrees from accredited post-secondary institutions. Scholarships will be applied to the cost of undergraduate tuition, fees and on-campus room and board.

CRITERIA:

To receive consideration, applicants must:

- be residents of Forsyth County
- be graduating high school seniors
- have a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.5 and a transcript reflecting a challenging course selection
- demonstrate outstanding leadership, character, and team spirit
- be members of the girls or boys varsity soccer team at Mt. Tabor High School

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Students who are interested in applying for this scholarship should contact the guidance office at Mt. Tabor High School for details on how to apply. In addition, students must provide the following items to the Mt. Tabor High School Selection Committee:

- grade transcript through the first semester of the 12th grade
- one-page narrative written by the student that addresses his/her personal leadership, character, and team spirit

SELECTION PROCESS:

A scholarship committee at Mt. Tabor High School will review all narratives and grade transcripts and select recipients. The committee reserves the right to rescind an award should a recipient's circumstances change, such as failure to graduate from high school or failure to enroll at an accredited institution. The Foundation reserves the right to withhold the award in the event that no applicants are deemed to meet the qualifications.

PAYMENT PROCESS:

Once the Foundation receives the selected recipient's information from the scholarship committee, checks will be issued jointly to the college and to the recipient, and will be mailed to the recipient's home address for the student to deliver to the college's financial aid office. Separate checks will be issued for fall and spring semesters. Check processing requires approximately two weeks.

MANAGEMENT OF FUND:

The Josh Gray Memorial Scholarship is administered by The Winston-Salem Foundation. As the fund grows, the number and dollar amount of scholarships may be increased.
