

L. Gordon, Jr. and June D. Pfefferkorn Scholarship for Forsyth Technical Community College Guidelines

DEADLINE: April 15

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

The L. Gordon, Jr. and June D. Pfefferkorn Scholarship may be awarded to graduating high school seniors in Forsyth County who are attending Forsyth Technical Community College. The scholarship will provide up to two consecutive years of financial assistance to a recipient selected each year. Scholarships are to be applied to cost of tuition, fees, and expenses to include, but not limited to, books, childcare, transportation, etc.

CRITERIA:

To be considered, applicants must:

- attend Forsyth Technical Community College
- be a resident of Forsyth County
- have achieved a high school cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5
- demonstrate financial need, but not restricted to lowest family incomes
- be a graduating high school senior

APPLICATION PROCESS:

The [application](#) is available on Forsyth Tech's Web site at www.ForsythTech.edu. The following items must be submitted by the deadline:

- two references - one from one of your teachers and the other from a teacher, current employer or guidance counselor - [download forms](#)
- high school grade transcript

The application and all supplemental materials must be received by the deadline of April 15 in order to receive consideration. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Once applications and all requested materials have been received, the Students Financial Services Committee at Forsyth Tech will review applications and select a recipient.

RENEWAL PROCESS

Recipients receiving renewal awards for the second year must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, reside in Forsyth County, and maintain full time enrollment at Forsyth Tech.
