Foundation Announces January Community Grants

The Winston-Salem Foundation announces **26 Community Grants totaling \$558,143.00** that will touch the lives of many living in Forsyth County. Grants were awarded to organizations in the following program areas: animal welfare, arts and culture, education, environment, health, human services, and public interest. The grants are the following:

- **Arts Council of Winston-Salem and Forsyth County** - \$30,000 for the director of marketing for a second year
- **Associates in Christian Counseling**- \$8,000 to support a part-time intake coordinator position for a second year
- **Ava Gardner Museum** - \$7,000 to improve the theatre
- **Cancer Services** - \$18,000 to support an African-American and a Hispanic/Latino outreach educator for a third year
- **Catholic Charities Diocese of Charlotte** - \$50,000 for an immigration attorney
- **Children's Home Society of NC** - \$7,000 for marketing
- **Community Care Center for Forsyth County** - \$30,000 to support a diabetic case manager/educator for a third year
- **Exchange SCAN** - \$12,768 to expand the parent/teen education group for a third year
- **Experiment in Self-Reliance** - \$19,875 for a part-time finance accountant assistant
- **Forecast Music** - \$500 for a collaborative chamber music performance
- **Forsyth Humane Society** - \$20,000 for additional staff for a third year
- **Forsyth Spay Day Coalition** - \$3,500 to support spay/neuter services in Forsyth County for a third year
- **Hispanic Arts Initiative** - \$1,000 for a cultural art experience
- **Home Moravian Church** - \$500 to support a free concert by the Smithills School Senior Brass Band
- **Imprints** - \$20,000 for a business development director for a second year
- **Next Step Ministries** - \$8,000 to support a nighttime staff position for a third year

- **Northwest Child Development Centers** - \$30,000 to support an education technology integration specialist for a third year
- **Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center Foundation** - \$35,000 to help support costs for 24-hour call center counselors at the Behavioral Health Center for a third year
- **SECU Family House** - \$20,000 to support the manager of educational services for a third year
- **Senior Services** - \$40,000 to expand the Home Care program for high-risk seniors
- **Shepherd's Center of Greater Winston-Salem** - \$15,000 to support a part-time senior center program assistant for a third year
- **Southside United Health Center** - \$42,000 for a physician assistant/nurse practitioner
- **The Centers for Exceptional Children** - \$50,000 to provide transportation services for the infant/toddler program
- **WinstonNet** - \$30,000 to expand the executive director position's part-time hours
- **Winston-Salem Street School** - \$35,000 to support a development director for a second year
- **Yadkin Riverkeeper** - \$25,000 for branding and marketing

The Winston-Salem Foundation is a community foundation that supports charitable programs in the greater Forsyth County area.
